STAMPIN UP SUPPLIES USED:

Stamps: Cup of Christmas (150491), Handwritten (152063)

Die Cutting: Cup of Cheer Dies (151150), Stitched Shapes Dies (152323)

Cardstocks: Crumb Cake (120953), Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730)

DSP: Toile Tidings (150432)

Ink: Garden Green (147089), Crumb Cake (147116), Early Espresso (126974)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Simply Scored (122334), Bone Folder (102300)

Misc: Whisper White 3x3 Envelopes (145829), Toile Tidings Glitter Dots (150433), Starbucks Gift Card

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

CUTTING MEASUREMENTS:

Base: Crumb Cake - 4 1/4" x 8 3/4" - scored at 4 1/4" and 4 1/2"

Inside Early Espresso Layer - 3 3/4" x 3 3/4"

Inside Crumb Cake Layer - 3 5/8" x 3 5/8"

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COVER:



- Cut the base and make two score lines as detailed in the cutting measurements above
- Fold along those score lines and use your Bone Folder to make them nice and crisp
- Use Crumb Cake Ink to ink up your background stamp and stamp it onto both of the Gray Granite layers
- Stamp and die cut the green cups and use Snail adhesive to adhere them in place
- Stamp the sentiment, die cut it out and adhere on top of the cups using Dimensionals
- Add some green glittered dots and your front is done!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE INSIDE:



- Adhere the Early Espresso layer onto the inside base and the stamped Crumb Cake layer on top
- Take a 3" x 3" envelope and cut off the flap to create a pouch



- Cut a strip of patterned paper to go across the envelope and adhere in place
- Pop a Gift Card into the envelope and your treat is ready for gifting 😊



I hope that you enjoyed creating your own Gift Card Holder – you can of course theme it for any occasion simply by changing the stamps and patterned papers
